Deed of Sale from Lewis Felt to John C. Farmer, conveying Felt's interest in the slave belong-
ing to Edwin Rice estate, also his interest in the punishable estate was acknowledged in the
Clerk's Office the 17th day of July 1843 by said Felt and admitted to Record.
Deed of trust between Joseph C. Smith of the first part Seth D. Williams of the second part
and Hunning T. Smith of the third part, conveying land, slaves, cattle & other personal
property was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 17th day of July 1843 by Joseph C. Smith
one of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between John A. Gardner of the first part Seth D. Williams of the second part
& Hunning T. Smith of the third part conveying horses, cattle, hogs and other personal prop-
erty was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 27th day of April 1843 by H. T. Smith
party thereto and was proved by the oath of R. H. Beaman a witness thereto as to the
accuracy thereof. And in the Office the 3rd day of July 1843 the said Deed was
proved by the oath of H. H. Cooper another witness thereto as to its accuracy and in said Office
the 17th day of July 1843 the said Deed was acknowledged by said Gardner a party thereto
committed to Record.

Deed of trust between Abram Holland of the first part, Meredith Holland of the second
part and Henry Fowler of the third part, conveying crop, corn, grass, oats, barley &
other property in the Clerk's Office the 17th day of July 1843 by Neeson & Meredith Holland two of the parties
thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Mills Sage of the first part Ed Wright Nash of the second part and
Richard Rardon of the third part, conveying land, was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office
the 17th day of July 1843 by all the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from William joyner and wife to Harrison Clark conveying land, was ac-
knowledged in the Clerk's Office the 17th day of July 1843 by Wm. Joyner & party, husband
together with the certificate of the privity examination and acknowledgement of the wife who
committed to Record.

Deed of trust between Thomas M. Nevel of the first part James H. Ladson of the second part and
Hargrave and Chappell and others of the third part, conveying crop of corn, oats, barley &
other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 17th day of July 1843 by
said Nevel. Ladson & Hargrave three of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between James D. Williams of the first part William P. Moore of the second
part and Abram Reddick of the third part, conveying land, horse, cattle, hogs &
other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 17th day of July 1843
by said Williams & Reddick two of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Ethelreda E. Briggs of the first part Ed Wright Nash of the second part
and George A. W. Neeson of the third part, conveying slaves was acknowledged in the
Clerk's Office the 17th day of July 1843 by Briggs & Nash two of the parties thereto
and admitted to Record.
