On the motion of John W Thomas who made oath & gave bond & security according to Law certificat is granted him for obtaining letters of armor. He being now in John Rockells the younger etc in New Haven

The next 20th before Simon Markee guardian of Martha Averill & Mary Wells infant children of William A Wells and therupon he gave bond & security according to Law

On the motion of Wells Bradshaw guardian of Marshall & Sarah Bradshaw and for reasons appearing to Court. Ordered that she said Wells Bradshaw make sale of one or more of the slaves of his master Marshall Bradshaw as well be sufficient to satisfy the sum of \$260 000 with interest demand paid the 21st day of March 1843 that he also sell one or more of the slaves of his master Garrison Bradshaw as will be sufficient to satisfy the sum of \$286 67 00 with interest paid 21st March 1843 except being the amounts respectively due from the said slaves to John Vick their former guardians as per last Cols report heretofore returned to Court ^{the same} several sums of money have been apaid by John Vick to William A Rockell to satisfy ^{the same} same sum

Ordered that the proper people stand against the persons presented by the grand jury this day returnable here to the next quarterly Court

On the motion of John D Works who made oath and gave bond and security according to Law certificat is granted him for obtaining letters of armor at the estate of Samuel Rockell etc in New Haven

Bonds to Colb N M etc for £100 - It appearing to the Court that the defendant have had legal notice of the motion they were plainly called but came not Therefore judgment is granted in full to the Bifs for the sum of £100 less costs to be discharged by the payment of the principal sum on our hands with interest from the date till paid etc
