was this day set to the bar in custody of the Keeper of the Jail of this County (the Court
summons for her examination having failed to make her said being herself an ignorant pleader
is not guilty. Whereupon sundry witnesses were sworn & examined & the prisoner by Counsel
fully heard. the Court after hearing the testimony & from all the circumstances are of
opinion that the prisoner is not guilty of the felony of which she stands charged
or in pleading the habeas corpus. And thereupon it is ordered that the prisoner be forthwith
discharged from custody.
