repairs of the bridge across the Bottomway river at Jerusalem near the road
when completed & make report to the Court

On motion of James D. Bryant Ordered that Justices R. Edwards do take
pelle & adjust an account of the said Bryant's guardianship of Mary Taylor &
Ann Bryant & make separate reports

On motion of Robert S. Prillon for leave to build a water grant mill &c. ^{the Court}
came as well the petitioner by his attorney as Mary White & Charles White prop-
rietary of the land found liable to damage by their attorney & for reason appearing to
the Court the petition is continued till the next Term.
