William A Jones Esq^r this day appeared in Court and moved the Court to grant him the administration

Francis B Jones also a creditor who desired the Court to grant him the administration on said
estate. The Court after hearing the parties by their attorneys granted the administration above to
the said William A Jones upon his giving bond with security in the penalty of One thousand
dollars with good security & conditioned according to Law Whereupon the said William A Jones offered to
enter into said bond & tendered Joseph P. Head & Sampson & Rose as his security which was deemed
sufficient by the Court, but before the said bond was entered into the said Francis B
Jones prayed and appealed from the opinion of the Court to the next Circuit Superior Court of Law
and Chancery for the County which is granted him upon his giving bond with security in
the penalty of \$100. Conditioned according to Law - which was accordingly done.

The Court doth appoint William A Jones Curator of the estate of Elizabeth McElmire deceased
during the contest about the amount of her estate whereupon the said Jones gave bond
with security according to Law

Ordered that Horrell Morris, John Austin, Nathan N Thomas, & Henry Moore or any
3 of them being Sworn do appear all the personal estate of Elizabeth McElmire
deceased & return the said appearance &

Ordered that the sum of ~~any~~ contingent monies in his hands pay James H. Jackson the
sum of \$30. for inhabiting Clappiss Village

On motion of John Hannicutt Ordered that John J. Mason who is hereby appointed
Special Commissioner for the purpose shall make & report an account of his said Commission
to the Court in due time & make report to the Court of Daniel Bullo de & make report to the

Daniel N Drayton jailor of this County reported to the Court that a Runaway slave
has been committed to the jail without his master's money whereupon the Court appointed
Geo A. W. Stevens John H. Robbie & William Brown to view & report to the Court the
value of the said Runaway whereupon they appeared in Court & were sworn according to Law

For reasons appearing to the Court Ordered that the Poor land belonging to Mrs. Mary
Brown girl to Elizabeth Bradshaw according to Law without the said Bradshaws
& paying her money for the hire of said land.

For reasons appearing to the Court Ordered that the Poor land Longstone Park
daughter of Lucia Parks formerly to Barnett & Griffin according to Law the said
Griffin paying to the mother of said Lucy and the sum of \$4. per year the last year
payment to be made to the apprentice.

Ordered that the Estate of David Jones deceased be committed to the hands of William
Elliott Sheriff of this County for delivery according to Law -
