

The last Will and Testament of Jordan Pope ad. was proved by the oath of Samuel Drury
and John A. Folsom one of the subscribing witnesses thereof & ordered to be recorded.

William A. Jones this day appeared in Court and moved the Court to grant him the administration on the estate of Elizabeth M. Senner ad. in the said William A. Jones claiming to be the last and true executor of the estate of the said Elizabeth M. Senner. — which motion was opposed by Francis B. Jones also a creditor ^{and son-in-law & distributee} who desired the Court to grant him the administration on said estate. The Court after hearing the parties by their attorneys granted the administration to the said William A. Jones upon their executing bond with security in the penalty of one thousand dollars with good security ^{as conditioned} to Law whereupon the said William A. Jones offered to execute said bond & Francis B. Jones & Joseph T. Bond & Sampson LeRue as his security which was deemed sufficient by the Court. but before the said bond was entered into the said Francis B. Jones prayed an appeal from the opinion of the Court to the next Circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery for this County which is granted him upon his giving bond with security in the penalty of \$1000 conditioned according to Law — which was accordingly done.

The Court doth appoint William A. Jones executor of the estate of Elizabeth M. Senner ad. during the contest about the admov. of said estate whereupon the said Jones gave bond & security according to Law.

Ordered that Horrell Mann, John Studier, Nathan A. Thomas, & Denny Moore or any 3 of them being sworn if appeared all the personal estate of Elizabeth M. Senner ad. & return the said appraisement if.

Ordered that the Sheriff out of any contingent moneys in his hand pay James A. Johnston the sum of \$50. for retainer of his billage.

On motion of John Himmelfuth Ordered that John T. Almond who is hereby appointed Special Commissioner for this purpose state what he requests an account of the said Himmelfuth admo. on this matter & state if he make report if of Daniel Wells ad. & make report to the Court.

Daniel A. Drury one of the Justices of this County reported to the Court that a Runaway slave has been committed to the Jail within the last three months whereupon the Court appointed Geo. A. Wetmore, John W. Richelle & William Brown to see & report to the Court the value of the said Runaway. whereupon they appeared in Court & were sworn according to Law.

For reasons appearing to the Court Ordered that the Poor bond Cherry Kingman & free negro girl to Elizabeth Bradshaw according to Law without the said Bradshaw's paying any thing for the hire of said Cherry.

For reasons appearing to the Court Ordered that the Poor bond Langelston Pickens daughter of Linn Pickens free negro to Burnett & Griffin according to Law the said Geo. H. H. paying to the mother of said Langelston the sum of \$10. per year — the last year's payments to be made to the apprentices.

Ordered that the estate of David Jones ad. be committed to the hands of William A. Everett Sheriff of this County for debtors according to Law —
