Deed of bargain and sale from George Wilson wife to William H. Gammie & others conveying land was returned in the Office the 30th day of October 1843 and together with the other documents of the said Wilson wife acknowledged before the Justices of the peace & admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Lieutenant R. Edwards Commissioner of the State of New Hampshire & A. Whistell Atkinson conveying land, was acknowledged in the Office the 5th day of November 1843 by said Edwards & admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between John C. Towner of the first part William B. Brooks of the second part and Nicholas W. Schmitt Peter Edwards Harry Hendrick Rose & Co. & Edward C. Edwards John McCarley and Nathaniel J. Williams conveying land, negroes slaves and other personal property was acknowledged in the Office the 6th day of November 1843 by said Towner & Brooks the two of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of mortgage between Henry Carr of the first part & Rufus Dunning of the second part at Henniker D. Moore of the third part conveying his interest in a certain tract of land, cattle & other personal property was made in the Office the 5th day of November 1843 by the each of Samuel B. Willard & a wife, trustees, and in said Office the 11th day of November the said indenture was proved by the oath of David Carr & Willie Dunc the subscriber thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from James Vick to John Waddill conveying lands was acknowledged in the Office the 13th day of November 1843 by said Vick and admitted to Record.

The accounts current and Commissioners reports of Henry T. Poole steward on Abram Pease's estate of Ambridge Gardner attorney for Abram Pease estate and of James Vick's guardianship of Henry Poole's affairs having been in full and no complaints being filed were severally examined and ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that Harrison D. Moore, James D. Bryant, Mills D. Turner, Jonathan Whiteford and Roy Perry or any three of them being sworn if appear all the personal estate of James Whiteford & co and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.
