John M. Gurley & Samuel Kelle who have been appointed Com. of the Revenue recently gave bond with security according to Law which bond was not. & O.R.

Peter Edwards having drawn no attachment against the estate of John M. Rice his tenant for \$100. for rent which will become due on the 25th day of December next. And defendant having made return (therein stating) This day came the plaintiff by his attorney & the Defendant not appearing to reply to the attached effect. it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the Defendant the said sum of \$100. & the costs. And it is ordered that the landlord make sale of the aforesaid attached effects according to law on a credit until the 25th day of December next and assign the proceeds or so much thereof as is sufficient to the plaintiff solicitor of this judgment & the balance return to the Defendant And return an account of such sale to Court.

Ordered that the following accounts to wit one in favour of Jesse Drury for \$185. one in favour of Harmon D. Moore amounting to \$3.36. One in favour of Richard Smith amounting to \$5.43. one in favour of William S. Everett Hoff amounting to \$46.00 & one in favour of Miles D. Burrum amounting to \$29.55^{cts} be paid to the Auditor of Public accounts for his recommendation & payment.

The Court certifies that it appears to them from evidence introduced that Miles D. Burrum was the apprehender of William Jones a free negro who was charged with being a runaway and afterwards convicted of that offence by the Court of Accomack County.

John G. Vick who is in custody of the Sheriff by virtue of two execution in the name of Alfred S. Bailey, owner of James Smith was brought into Court & subscribed & delivered no schedule of his estate and made oath thereof according to Law. Whereupon it is ordered that the said Vick be discharged of detention for no other cause.

David Anson who is in custody of the Sheriff by virtue of an execution at the suit of James B. Williams was brought into Court and subscribed & delivered no schedule of his estate and made oath thereof according to Law. Whereupon it is ordered that the said Anson be discharged of detention for no other cause.
