

Dance Request as before question of William J. Bonnett, now thereupon to give bond & security according to law

Present George A. M. Newman, Jesse Parker, Robert G. Griffin, John Vick, William D. Hoad, James D. Bryant, L. P. Nicholson, Francis T. Ridley, Thomas Ridley.

The Court proceeds to elect a Coroner to supply the vacancy created in the upper district of Adirondack provided by the resignation of William R. Stephenson and the final vote of the Court was as follows.

For Arthur A. Denney, the votes were: Jacob Burnett, John Vick, W. D. Hoad, James D. Bryant, L. P. Nicholson, Francis T. Ridley, Thomas Ridley, 7.

For George A. M. Newman, the votes were: George A. M. Newman, Jesse Parker, Robert G. Griffin, Benjamin Griffin, Alexander Maynard & Thomas B. Bonnell, 6. Arthur A. Denney, having a majority of votes was declared elected. It appearing to the Court that the said Denney was a man of honesty, probity & good character.

Samuel B. Hume who has been appointed Sheriff of this County by a Commission from the Governor under the seal of the Commonwealth, dated the 25 day of March 1863 to take effect from the expiration of the term of the present Sheriff and to continue in Office until his first quarterly Court to be held in this County in the year 1865. This day entered into three several bonds with surety conditioned according to law in the penalty of \$32,000 each which bonds were returned by the obligors therein named by Order to be received.

Account Current of Shagan Lavin Constabulary of Lusheran Sain was returned & ordered to be returned for explanation.

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On motion of Joseph P. Dutton against Thomas P. Dutton administrator of said P. Dutton dec'd for bonded security. This day came the parties by their attorneys who being heard it is ordered that the said Thomas P. Dutton give the said Joseph P. Dutton good counter security according to law and the said Thomas P. Dutton refusing to give the said security it is ordered that his duties & powers as administrator be revoked & annulled and that the said Thomas P. Dutton pay the said Joseph P. Dutton his costs.

On motion of James E. Patten: Ordered That Master Court Clerk examine the books of said Patten & forward a report of the expenses of Henry B. Patten dec'd & make report of. And it is ordered that the guardian do expend \$25. of the principal of each of his wards stated for their support & education.

The request of Spencer D. Foster, Anthony Bird, Sam Bird, Michael Bird & David Bird, guardian of said Foster & Bird, to be taken into consideration.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
