On motion of David W. Simmons against George W. Spring, R. A. Vignat & J. H. Vignat. This day came the parties by their attorneys who being fully heard the Court ordered by the Court that the said motion be overruled and that the defendants pay the costs in this behalf expended.

For Richard D. Boggess the votes were - Robert L. Griffith & Benjamin Griffith. Anthony M. Howell having a majority of the whole number of votes was declared elected. It appearing to the Court that he is a man of honesty, probity & good character.

Anthony A. Hallen is appointed surveyor of the road leading from the Swamp near Miller's bridge meeting house to Nathan Pope in the name of the said Pope dec^d and it is ordered that the usual bonds be taken thereon.
