On motion of Thomas H. Norwell son of Matthew Vick. Ordered that Master Lewis Cobb examine that & settle the said Vick's account of Sally Vick (now Sally Gardner) and report the same &c

J. Hobson - After having obtained an attachment against the estate of Patrick Loveling where the said Moore himself intend to remain his effects for \$149. 70/100 cent ready account. And the constable having made return \$14 (Courtment) Therefore came the pffl by his attorney with the Dft not appearing. It is considered by the Court that the pffl recover against the Dft the said sum of \$149. 70/100 cent and his costs by reason of this behalf expenses. And it is ordered that George M. Hollings one of the garnishers pay to the pffl. \$2.50 cent. & Charles Holland another garnisher pay the sum of \$16.00 the amounts respectively due from them to the pffl in part satisfaction of this judgment. And it is ordered that Robert Edwards author of the garnishers be summoned to this next Court to declare on oath what amount is due from him to the Dft.
