had been committed to the Jail of this County charged with stealing goods
(wearing apparel) to the amount of \$22. - was then being set to the libel custody
of the Jailor of this Court (the Court summoned for his trial having failed to come)
and was heard by Coughlin. Whereupon the Court doth order that the said
said slave, fifteen dollars on his own back will bond on at the public wharf
paying post that the Sheriff cause execution of this judgment to be done forthwith
and then discharge the prisoner from custody.
