

The Court doth appoint Augustus Williams Surveyor of the road from the embarkment near Jerusalem to Parsons road at the corner of Chas W. Mathews corner & it is ordered that the said hands work thereon.

John Drury vs. J. D. Bryant Esqr. Bailey Bryant & Co. De Debt. This day came the parties in their proper persons, and by their counsel it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the debt the sum of \$450. with legal interest thereon from the 22^d April 1842 & to pass after costs. To be levied of the goods & chattels of the defendant in the hands of the Deft. to be understood &c.

John M. Gurley foreman, John Davis, Alfred Ricks, Tho. J. Prall, H. D. Moore, Thaddeus Tutwiler, Arthur Gardner, Bennett Jones, John Drury, Ellen Kitchen, Annister Gorman, Wm. Rochelle, George Crump, Mills D. Sumner, Joseph Jones & Joseph B. Davis were sworn a grand jury of inquest for the body of John Smith, and having reviewed their charge withdrawn and after some time returned and Court appeared (Chas. in court) and having nothing further to present were discharged.

Ordered that William Bowser, Wm. B. Gooding & John Drury Lewis Harris or any through them let to the Court undertake the repairs of Morris bridge, receive the same when completed and make report &c.

The Registers of Henry Turner Jordan Bailey Robert Bailey Freely Freeman and free negroes were examined & certified to be truly made.

For reasons appearing to the Court It is ordered that the O'Ben bond Ben. Hawthorne & Ephraim J. Dilas free negro boys to George Crump according to Law, and that the said Crump pay for the services of the said apprentices as follows for Ben. Hawthorne \$500 annually for Ephraim \$75. For Dilas \$10 annually, which sums are to be paid to the Overseers of the poor except for the last years apprenticeship which is to be paid to the apprentices respectively.

Ordered that the account of David D. Stone Esqr. amounting to \$35 be certified to the Auditors of public accounts for the examination & payment.

The Court are unanimous in recommending Samuel B. Davis William Briggs & Jacob D. Jones sent to the Governor of the Commonwealth as fit proper persons to execute the Office of Sheriff of this County the ensuing year.

William vs. J. D. Hancock Esqr. Bill & answer filed and done as per decree.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till to morrow morning 10 O'Clock
