

The Court doth appoint Augustus Williams Surveyor of the road from the embankment near Jerusalem to Marion and the sum of £1000 Board and expenses & it is ordered that the said Courts make therewith.

John Drury v. Job D'Booyat Esq. Baileys Brigadier etc. His Debt. This day came this parties in their proper persons and by their cause etc. examined by the Court that the debt now unpaid etc. left the sum of \$850. with legal interest thereon from the 22<sup>nd</sup> April 1822 till paid etc. etc. To be levied of the goods & chattels of the defendant in the hand of the Sheriff to be administered etc.

Davis were sworn a grand jury of inquest for the body of this County and having viewed their charge with due care after sometime returned with this present Indictment which in part etc. was having nothing further to present were discharged.

\* Ordered that William Prince, Wm B. Goddard & John Drury their heirs or any of them etc. let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of Morris bridge, over the sum when completed and make report etc.

\* The Registers of Henry Turner, Jordan Bailey, Robert Bailey, Freely Freeman etc. free negroes were examined & certified to be truly made.

For reasons appearing to the Court It is ordered that the Poor bind Ben. Hinchliffe & Ephraim of Belas free negro boys to George Crump according to Law. and that the said Crump pay for the service of the said apprentices as follows for Ben. Hinchliffe \$100 dollars annually for Ephraim \$7. For Belas \$10 annually. which sums are to be paid to the Masters of the poor except for the last year apprenticeship which is to be paid to the apprentices respectively -

Ordered that the account of Sam'l B. Stone etc. amounting to \$8.35 be certified to the Auditor of public accounts for his examination & payment.

The Court are unanimous in recommending Samuel B. Stone, William Briggs & Jacob Barnes Esq's to the Governor of the Commonwealth as fit & proper persons to execute the Office of Sheriff of this County the ensuing year.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till to morrow Morning 10 o'clock
