Court in this County.

Subscribed Will & Testament of Sarah D. Williams in was proved by the oath of Elizabeth S.
Williams & William A. Pickens the subscribing witnesses thereto & ordered to be recorded. Robert
Pickens & John Davis the executors named appeared in Court & refused to take upon
themselves the further of the execution thereof.

A Receipt from Enoch Woodward to Samuel W. Woodward was produced in Court and there
being no subscribing witness thereto John Woodward being sworn deponee & deposes that he is
acquainted with the hand writing of the said Enoch Woodward & verily believes the name of the
said Enoch Woodward to the said receipt subscribed is in the proper hand writing of the said
Enoch Woodward. Whereupon it is ordered that the said receipt be recorded.

A Receipt from John Woodward to Samuel W. Woodward was produced in Court there being no subscribing
