ing to law.

Jonathan Darden is appointed guardian to Josephine & Samuel orphans of
Schools Johnson & this upon he gave bond of security according to law.

On the petition of Patrick H. Rollins who made oath of goods and
security according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of
administration on the estate of his deceased wife Ann in due form.

On the petition of Rodman G. Briffen who made oath of goods and security
according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of admin^{str} of the
estate of Thomas Herring dec^d in due form.

Joseph W. Davis v. Jas. D. Boyard Esq. Bonding Boyard dec^d - This day came
the parties by their attorneys & by their consent it is considered by the Court that the
plff: recover against the Def: the sum of \$50 with interest from 2^d day of January 1841
all paid & costs to be levied &c. - Subject to a credit of \$50.00 due from August
15th 1842.

the plff: recover against the Def: the sum of \$50.00 part of the debt in the account
