The last Will and Testament of Thomas Joyner dec^d was proved by the oath of
Matthew Mills, Matthew Norvell, &
Thence ordered to be recorded. & on the motion of Elijah Joyner the Court
therein named who made oath of ~~affirmation~~ ^{the subscribing witnesses} bond and security according to law
certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration or probate of the said
will in due form.

Ordered that Matthew Mills, Patrick Rowe, Matthew Harris & Jo. Joyner
or any three of them being sworn & appraise the personal estate of the Joyner dec^d
& return the same &c.

Jordan Edwards is appointed guardian to Mary Ann, Margaret J. & Louisa
D. White orphans of John D. White dec^d & this upon he gave bond & security accord-
ing to law.

Jonathan Darden is appointed guardian to Josephine & Samuel orphans of
Scholar Johnson & thereupon he gave bond & security according to law.

On the motion of Patrick H. Rollins who made oath & gave bond and
security according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of
administration on the estate of his deceased wife Ann in due form.

On the motion of Borden G. Briffen who made & gave bond & security
according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of admin^{str} of the
estate of Thomas Herring dec^d in due form.

Joseph D. Davis v. Jas. D. Boyant Exr. Bailey Boyant dec^d - This day came
the parties by their attorneys & by their consent it is considered by the Court that the
plff^t recover against the Def^t the sum of \$50.00 with interest from 2^d day of January 1841
till paid & costs to be levied &c. - Subject to a credit of \$35.00 due paid August
15th 1842.

George B. Cary v. James D. Boyant Exr. Bailey Boyant dec^d - This day came
the parties by their proper persons & by their consent it is considered by the Court that
the plff^t recover against the Def^t the sum of \$30.42 part of the debt in the court
mentioned with interest from 25th Decr. 1839 till paid & costs. To be levied &c.

the plaintiff recover against the Def^t \$20.42 with interest from the 1st day
