Jacob's Inquest. vs James D Bryant Exor. Bailey Bryant dec'd. This day came the parties by their attorneys and by their consent it is ordered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the deft \$67. 64 with interest from 15 September 1860 till paid & costs. To be levied &c. Subject to a writ of \$50. paid June 12th 1862.

On motion of John R Williams he is exempt from the payment of taxes in future he being insane.

Ordered that Seth D Williams, Sime Parker, Meredith Holland do let to the lowest undertaker the repairs or rebuilding the bridge at A D South quay - receive the same when completed. make report &c.

The Court proceeded to elect a constable to supply the vacancy occasioned by the resignation of Nathaniel B Bryant. and the vote of the Court being taken *Viva Voce* resulted as follows

For Nathaniel Seabell the votes were - N M Seabell, Carr Brown, L. P. Nicholson, James Maugher, Tho B Morrill, A. Merrick, B A M Newman, Jacob Daniels, Henry Blair, B. E. Pope, & T. Ridley. 11

For James D Bryant the votes were H. J. Smith & James D Bryant. 2

Septha Parker having a majority of the whole number of votes was declared duly elected it appearing to the Court that the said Seabell is a man of honesty of probity & good demeanor. And thereupon the said Seabell qualified by taking the oaths prescribed by Law, and entered into bond with security as the law directs which bond was acknowledged by the obligors therein named &c Dr. Reed.

On motion of John Seabrough Jr. security for Elizabeth B. Seabrough for her guardianship of her infant children. Ordered that she be summoned to the next Court to give the said Seabrough good and true security according to Law.

The Registers of Legal Acts, Gardiner Brown, James Hunt, William Hunt, Nicholas Whitfield & Jeremiah Whitfield for papers were examined & certified to be truly made.

On motion of Samuel B. Hunt Sheriff of this County, James D Mapentury, William Parker, Wm B. James, James Mapentury, William A. Bell & Benjamin H. Goodenough are permitted to qualify as his deputies during his pleasure, and thereupon they qualified according to Law. It appearing to the Court that the said J. D Mapentury, Parker, James D Mapentury, Bell & Goodenough are men of honesty, probity & good demeanor.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the morning 10. March.
