This day (was) the parties by their attorneys and by their counsel it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the diff \$67. 64 with interest from 15 September 1852 full paid & late To be levied &c. Subject to a writ of \$50. paid June 12 1862.

On return of John R Williams he is exempt from the payment of taxes in future he being infirm.

Ordered that Seth D Williams, Sime Parker, Meredith Holland do let to the lowest undertaker the repairs or rebuilding the bridge at old South quay - receive the same when completed & make report &c

The Court proceeded to elect a constable to supply the vacancy occasioned by the resignation of Nathaniel B Bryant. and the vote of the Court being taken viva voce resulted as follows

For Saphael Powell, the votes were - N. M. Seball, Carr Brown, L. P. Nicholson James Mages, Tho B Morrell, A. Myrick, R. A. W. Newsum Jacob Daniels Henry Blair, R. E. Pope, & J. Ridley. 11

For Wm B Bryant the votes were H. J. Smith & James D Bryant. 2

Sophia Parker having a majority of the whole number of votes was declared duly elected it appearing to the Court that the said Powell is a man of honesty of probity & good demeanor. And thereupon the said Powell qualified by taking the oaths prescribed by Law, and entered into bond with security as the law directs which bond was acknowledged by the obligors therein named & Dr. Reed.

On return of John Scarborough &c security for Elizabeth Bopst for her guardianship of her infant children. Ordered that she be summoned to the next Court to give the said Scarborough good & certain security according to Law

The Registers of Ligea Arles, Gardini Brown, James Hunt, William Hunt, Nicholas Whitfield & Primm Whithead for negroes were examined & certified to be truly made.

On application of Samuel B Davis Sheriff of this County, James D Mapentony, William Parker, Wm B James, James Mapentony, William A Bell & Douglass W Gooden are permitted to qualify as his deputies during his absence, and thereupon they qualified according to Law. It appearing to the Court that the said J. D Mapentony, Parker, James D Mapentony, Bell & Gooden are men of honesty & probity & good demeanor.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the morning 10. Clock.
