Ordered that the Sheriff collect from Thomas Reddy the sum of \$13.50 due from him for the purchase of some old bridge timber and account therefore to the Court on his account.

Summary list of Insolvent Taxes amounting to \$289.12 for the year 1841 were returned as annexed & allowed by the Court.
