Satisfactory evidence was adduced in Court to prove that Louisa Gray formerly Louisa Bryant wife of Richard C. Gray is the only identical daughter of Ephraim Bryant dec^d. who served in the late War of 1812 under Capt. Thomas M. Nelson as a private soldier in the 10th Regiment of Infantry and that she the said Louisa Gray formerly Louisa Bryant is the only heir at law in fee to him the said Ephraim Bryant aforesaid.

Satisfactory evidence was adduced in Court to prove that Ann Davis is the only identical widow of Lillston Davis dec^d. who served in the late War of 1812 under Capt. Bellomont as a private in the 6th Regiment Virginia Militia and that she the said Ann Davis is the only heir at law in fee to him the said Lillston Davis late a private in the aforesaid Regiment.

Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting Justices of this Court to the first day of October Term next. to appear personally to prosecute the laws in this County.
