Satisfactory evidence was adduced in Court to prove that Alex Realy a citizen & identical brother of William Realy dec'd. who was served in the late War of 1812 as private in the 6th Regiment of the Virginia Militia under Captain Ephraim Rainier of said Regiment and that the said Alex Realy is the only heir at law in fee to him in the said William Realy late a private in the aforesaid Regiment.

Satisfactory evidence was adduced in Court to prove that Louisa Gray formerly Louisa Bryant wife of Richard C. Gray is the only identical daughter of Ephraim Gray a citizen & who served in the late War of 1812 under Capt. Thomas M. Nelson as a private soldier in the 10th Regiment of Infantry and that the said Louisa Gray formerly Louisa Bryant is the only heir at law in fee to her late said Ephraim Gray aforesaid.

Satisfactory evidence was adduced in Court to prove that Ann Davis is the only identical sister of Littlebury Davis and who served in the late War of 1812 under Capt. H. Monroe as a private in the 65th Regiment Virginia Militia and that the said Ann Davis is the only heir at law in fee to her late said Littlebury Davis late a private in the aforesaid Regiment.

Ordered that the Sheriff Remount all the acting Justices of this Court to the first day of October Term next to appoint Commissioners to probate the laws in the County.
