On the motion of William J. Sebrell who made oath & gave bond & security according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Susan Bland de. in due form.

Ordered that Jesse Little, James S. James, William H. Means & Henry W. Butts or any 3 of them being sworn & approved all the personal estate of Susan Bland de. & return the same &c.

The Court doth assign William Harris guardian to Sarah A. Virginia, Harriet Martha & Mary J. Harris orphans of John Harris de. & settle upon the said and dower according to law.
