And it is ordered that the said Thomas B. Morris & Jacob Story out of any monies in his hands belonging to the said Whistfield pay to the plaintiff the amount this judgment upon condition that the said Phillips execute to the said Morris & Co. as aforesaid bond with security conditioned to refund to said Whistfield due proportion of any debts or demands which may hereafter come against the estate of the said James Story and the costs attending the recovery thereof.

On the motion of Nicholas W. Gibell who made oaths and gave bond & security according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of John J. Bratton do in due form.

Ordered that William H. Nicholson, Joseph Little, Daniel Webb, George M. Hale & any three of them being sworn & appraise all the personal estate of John J. Bratton in due form and make return yr.

On the motion of William J. Gibell who made oaths & gave bond & security according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Susan Hines do in due form.

Ordered that Joseph Little, Sam'l S. James, William H. Morris & Henry W. Bulle or any 3 of them being sworn & appraise all the personal estate of Susan Hines do & return the same yr.

The Court doth adjudge William Harris' guardianship Sarah A. Virginia, Henrietta & Mary J. Harris & the orphan of John Harris do & administer his goods bond and security according to law.
