The Court doth assign William Stephenson guardian to Stantonley & Polly Johnson orphans of Patience Johnson and therefore he gave bond & security according to Law.

The Court doth assign James Brown guardian to Virginia Barnes & of John Alderman & therefore he gave bond & security according to Law.

On motion of John M. Gurley setting forth that he is bound in this Court as security for Nathaniel T. Williams for his guardianship of Arthur & George Middleton orphans of Abner Middleton dec^d and that he conceives himself to be in danger of suffering damages by occasion thereof & praying the Court for relief. Ordered that the said Williams be summoned to appear to show cause why he should not be ordered to give the said John M. Gurley good counter security according to Law. Whereupon the said Nathaniel T. Williams by his attorney appeared & refusing to give the said security it is ordered that his power & duties as guardian be revoked & annulled & that he pay the said John M. Gurley his costs.

Arthur Middleton orphan of Abner Middleton made show of John M. Gurley for his guardianship & the Court assigns the said Gurley guardian to George Middleton orphan of said Abner Middleton & therefore he gave bond & security according to Law.

Drury, daughter of Joseph Drury dec^d and that he conceives himself to be in danger of suffering damages by occasion thereof & praying the Court for relief. Ordered that the said Williams be summoned to appear to show cause why he should not be ordered to give the said Gurley good counter security.
