Newson & Spratling & William being sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do now the way for said road as well as the present way & report to the Court the comparative convenience & inconvenience of.

On motion of Copeland Turner Ordered that James B. Mappenberg who is hereby appointed Special Commissioner for the purpose of the sale of said Turner's estate of Chasby Vanehan at & make report to Court.

On motion of Nathaniel P. Phillips Ordered that he as guardian of Virginia Ricket be allowed to expense of the transportation of her to the said Court the sum of £100. inclusive of the interest for the bond of £100.
