The Commissioners appointed to view and Report the propriety of
rebuilding the mill-race and erecting additional bridges on the road
side of the Millenay river near Germantown this day made their Report
Whereupon it is ordered that Henry B. Vaughan James W. Parker
G. A. W. Henson Benjamin Duran and W. P. Goodenough any 3 of whom
may act as let to the County undertake the extension of the mill-race
and the erection of any such bridges as they may deem necessary
when completed and Report to Court

The Account of Joseph & Powell Comptroller amounting to \$7.55 is
ordered to be referred to the auditor of public accounts for his examination
and payment

Commensurators against Monroe Butler The Defendant being solemnly
called and not appearing it is considered by the Court that the
Commensurators recover against the defendant the one hundred dollars the
fine by the jurors assessed and the cost of this prosecution and it is
ordered that a new writ of Capias aduolentem be awarded against the
said defendant returnable to the first day of the next Quarters Term to have
the further judgment of the Court

Commensurators & Counsel The Defendant by his attorney pleaded
not guilty to which the attorney for the Commensurators replied generally
and the cause is continued till the next term
