

At a Court summoned and held for the County of Southampton at the Court house thereof on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of May 1866 for the re-annation of Elijah Payne alias Drake of the said County charged with taking and stealing with intent to carry away certain parcel of corn estimated at two and one eighth Bunches of corn the property of James D M as Seabury

This Court being thus constituted the said Elijah Payne alias Drake appeared in Court according to the condition of his Recognizance entered into with Ely Payne and William M Conway his sureties before Wm A Spark a Justice of the Peace for this County and was set to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County and thereupon standing without Court seven and remanded and the finding by the Court fully heard and considered whereof it is the opinion of the Court that the said Drake ought to be further proceeded for the offence aforesaid and that such offence is cognizable before the Court of this County at Barrington or Medical of the said Division and the Court being of opinion that this is a suitable case he is allowed to give bail the said Elijah Payne alias Drake to be bound in the sum of two hundred dollars with two shewels in the sum of one hundred dollars each and three shewels the said Elijah Payne alias Drake with Ely Payne alias Drake and James Seabury his sureties in this Court to well and lawfully perform the conditions to be understood to the Commonwealth of Virginia the said Elijah Payne alias Drake in the sum of two hundred dollars and the said Ely Payne alias Drake in the sum of one hundred dollars each as their respective lands and personal goods and chattels to the use of the said Commonwealth endorsed up; upon this condition that if the said Elijah Payne alias Drake shall personally appear before the County Court of Southampton at the Court house of said County on the first day of the next month term of said Court by Justice D Clark Instructions then and then to answer the Commonwealth aforesaid for and concerning the offences aforesaid with which he stands charged and shall show and there it will appear what in the said Court shall be ordered and adjudged and shall not depart there without leave of the said Court then this Recognizance shall be void and remain in full force and virtue
