

A Court summoned and held for the County of Southampton at the Court house thereof on the 15th day of May 1846 for the remuneration of Elijah Rogers alias Drake of the said County charged with taking and stealing with intent to carry away certain parcel of corn situated at her and one eighth Parcel of land the property of James D M as Smling

This Court being thus constituted the said Elijah Rogers alias Drake appeared in Court according to the condition of his Recognizance returned into with Eliza Rogers and William M Conway his Sureties before Wm A Spark as Justice of the Peace for this County and was at to the end in custody of the Sheriff of this County and thereupon standing witness was sworn and examined and the finding by his Court fully heard and consideration whereof it is the opinion of the Court that the said Drake is to further proceeded for the offence aforesaid and that such offence is cognizable before the Court of this County Whereas on Motion of the said James and William being of opinion that this is a bailiable case he is allowed to give bail the said Elijah Rogers alias Drake to be bound in the sum of two hundred dollars with two sureties in the sum of one hundred dollars each and thereupon the said Elijah Rogers alias Drake with Eliza Rogers alias Drake and James M Conway his Sureties gave in Court severally acknowledged themselves to be indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia the said Elijah Rogers alias Drake in the sum of two hundred dollars and the said Eliza Rogers alias Drake and James M Conway in the sum of one hundred dollars each on their respective lands and tenements goods and chattels to the use of the said Commonwealth rendered up upon this condition that if the said Elijah Rogers alias Drake shall personally appear before the County Court of Southampton at the Court house of said County on the first day of the next monthly term of said Court by his or their Solicitors then and then to answer the Commonwealth aforesaid for and concerning the offence aforesaid with which he stands charged and shall show and there is and veries what in the said Court shall be ordered and adjudged and shall not depart therefrom without leave of the said Court then this Recognizance shall be void and the same in full force and virtue
