Barham being fully heard, it is the opinion of the Court & accordingly ordered, that the said Benjamin W. Barham enter into a recognizance himself in the sum of One hundred dollars with two sufficient sureties in the sum of fifty dollars each conditioned for his keeping the peace & being of good behaviour towards all the citizens of this Commonwealth particularly towards the said Lucinda Barham for the term of twelve months from this date and that he also pay the costs of this prosecution.
