 James D. Wiggins & examined & allowed by the Court & ordered to be certified
 to the Auditor of public Accounts.

On motion of Martha Pope. Ordered that she be exempt from payment
 of taxes $\frac{1}{2}$ for this slave Sarah & Charyns future they being aged & infirm.

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County out of any undivided monies on his
 hands not otherwise appropriated pay to Jordan Edwards ^{for services in paying out} ten dollars for
 procuring.

For reasons appearing to the Court, Ordered that the O. Post David New
 Hathcock & Ephraim & Elias free men pay to Richard Hemmick according
 to law and that the said Hemmick pay for the services of said apprentices as follows
 For David Hathcock Ten dollars annually - for Ephraim seven dollars annually &
 for Elias two dollars annually which said sums are to be paid to the O. Post except
 for the next year which is to be paid to the apprentices respectively.

On motion of Mary Whithead Ordered that she be exempt from the payment
 of taxes $\frac{1}{2}$ for ^{her} ~~her~~ ^{being} in future the being aged & infirm.

On motion of Jesse Glover. Ordered that he be exempt from the payment of taxes
 $\frac{1}{2}$ in future he being aged & infirm.

On motion of Jacob Jordan. Ordered that he be exempt from the payment of taxes
 $\frac{1}{2}$ in future he being aged & infirm.

On motion of Matthew R. Rochelle. Ordered that she be exempt from the pay-
 ment of taxes $\frac{1}{2}$ for Harriet Dick & Lucy in future he being aged & infirm.
