N B & H P. Pope having made complaint to a Justice of the peace of this County
that Drury Bittle has taken away some of the County property or otherwise
or concealed himself, so that the ordinary process of law could not be served upon
him, and the said Justice having granted an attachment against the estate
of the said Drury Bittle returnable to this Court which had been served upon
sundry goods &c to the said N B & H P. Pope this day appeared by their
attorney, and the said Drury Bittle was solemnly called but came not.
Whereupon came James H. Brill Coroner by his attorney who claimed the property
seized upon, and the said N B & H P. Pope and the said Brill came appeared by
their attorneys being fully heard. It is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover
against the Defendant the sum of \$403.89 with interest on fifty dollars & eighty four cents from the 28th
December 1844 till paid for \$55.75 the balance thereof from the
day of January 1847 till paid and their costs by them in this behalf.
