And it is ordered that the Officer who seized the said Attachment after taking and disposing of the goods and chattels attached as aforesaid And satisfied ^{being} the judgment this day rendered ^{against} attachment ⁱⁿ favor of B. & H. Pirell and the judgment in favor of B. & H. Pirell ^{that} be apply the balance in satisfaction of the judgment and the balance of any apply to ^{the} judgment rendered upon Attachment this day first and in favor of Sampson & Reed secondly One in favor of James H. Pirell thirdly One in favor of Peter Edwards and finally one in favor of Levi Waller and if any surplus should then remain that he return it to the defendant and the said Officer is required to return to the Clerk of the Court within thirty days after such sale is made & completed an Account of the sales specifying therein the several Articles sold the persons to whom sold and the price thereof.
