pay over to the said Biddle fifty dollars due her for support of
the said Rehe Biddle

James D. Haysbury Harrison & Peter William & Abel William
Mays and John D. Barham are permitted to qualify as his deputies
which appearing to the Court that the said Haysbury Peter William
Mays and Barham are Men of justly honest and good
character whereupon they took the several Oaths prescribed by
Law
