 was argued by counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge order and decree
 that the said report to which no exception has been filed be read before and settled and
 binding between the parties.

 and ordered to be recorded

 Thomas C. Freeman and of Isaac Briggs's guardianship of the heirs of Walter B. Smith
 having been once read and no exceptions being filed were generally confirmed & ordered to
 be recorded

✓ An Account Current & Commissioners Report of William A. Sparks executor
 proceedings on Charles Rockwells Est. of ^{Henry Brown} ~~James Brown~~ Occasional proceedings on
 "last Term" of Benjamin Wallers guardianship of Elizabeth J. Waller and of
 A. M. Sebells guardianship of C. & J. H. Summers were not ^{ordered to be entered for} exceptions.

✓ An Account Current of William J. Sebells admo. on David M. Williams' Est.
 was not ^{ordered to be entered for} exceptions.

✓ On motion of William Sutherland Ordered that one of the Commissioners of this Court
 shall settle and adjust an account of said Sutherland's guardianship of the estate of
 George A. C. Burdham ~~of the~~ and make report thereof to Court with any matters spe-
 cially stated claimed put in by himself or which he may be required to state.

✓ To Sutherland R. Edwards twenty five dollars are allowed for his services in examin-
 ing & certifying the books of the Commissioners of the Revenue this year.
