

Ordered that the estate of Joseph S. Nicholas be committed to the hands of Jacob Barnes sheriff for administration according to law

For Reasons appearing to Court: Ordered that James and Moses children of Moses Chappell, Jr. be bound to Henry Briggs by the Overseers of the Poor according to law for paying for the services of said children \$20. ^{and} Annually until their arrival at age.

On the Petition of Thomas S. Bristol and others for leave to open a New Road from the plantation of Thomas S. Bristol to the plantation of Franky Buffin it is Ordered that Willis Bradshaw, William R. Stephenson, Ed Copeland, Turner and A. S. B. Burgess or any three of them being sworn before a Justice of the peace for this County to view the Ground along which said Road is proposed to be conducted and Report to the Court the conveniences and inconveniences which will result thereunto as to the public in case said Road be opened as proposed.

Ordered that the Sheriff be ^{all the acting Justice of the peace} summoned to appear here on the first day of the next term to appoint an Attorney for the prosecution in behalf of the Commonwealth in this cause.

On Motion of Joseph S. Lihle Ordered that Commissioners George de Stak with and adjust an account of said Lihle administrator on the estate of George Bonit Jr. and make Report to Court with any matter so.

On Motion of Davis Barrett Ordered that one of the Commissioners of the Court take with and adjust an account of said Barrett Guardianship of Amos Pope and Report to Court.

Ordered that the account of William Musford (cont.) amounting to \$168 be certified the Auditor of public Accounts for his examination and payment.
