Joseph Edwin Fells who stands bound Recognizance for his appearance
and being to answer the complaint of Redwood Turner for break
of the Peace this day appeared in Court in discharge of his Bond
before Wherupon the said Redwood Turner and John Wilkes
were sworn and examined And the Joseph Edwin Fells by his
Counsel fully brought the Court after hearing the evidence
order that the said Joseph Edwin Fells enter into a Recape
and himself in the sum of fifty Dollars with few sufficient
securities in the sum of twelve dollars and fifty cent each consti
uted for keeping the peace towards the Commonwealth and all its
Subjects for the term of twelve Months; And that he also pay
the costs of the prosecution Whereupon the said Joseph Edwin
Fells together with Joseph H. Drown, Edward L. Simmons, Mc. Donnell
and Francis Fells his sureties here in Court severally acknowledged
themselves to owe to the Commonwealth of Virginia to wit the
said Fells in the sum of fifty dollars and each of the said
sure names in the sum of \$12.50 each to be divided of their
respective goods and chattels Lands and Tenantments to use of the said
Commonwealth to be rendered up. Upon the Condition that if the
said Joseph Edwin Fells shall keep the peace towards the Common
wealth and all its Subjects and especially towards the said Redwood
Turner for the term of twelve Months, then the obligation to be
void or else remain in full force.

Ordered it is that Mr. Gentry be appointed Surveyor to the said
inventories of the said Turner to William A. Sparks as Surveyor for the
benefit of said Turner wife and children in favor of said Sparks
who has removed from the Commonwealth.
