sureties in the sum of twelve dollars and fifty cent each each
and for keeping the peace towards the Commonwealth and all its
officers for the term of twelve months And that he also pay
the costs of this prosecution Wherrington the said Joseph Edwin
Fells together with Joseph H. Davis Edward L. Simmons M. B. Dorman
and Francis Fells the sureties here in Court doth severally acknow-
ledge themselves to owe to the Commonwealth of Virginia to wit the
said Fells in the sum of fifty dollars and each of the sureties
above named in the sum of twelve dollars and fifty cent each of their
