+ Robert Clifflin is appointed Guardian to his infant son John Clifflin. Whereupon the said Clifflin gave bond and security according to Law

On Motion of James D. Bryant Ordered that Quindion R. Edwards who is hereby appointed special Commissioner for the purpose to take take title and adjust and account of said Bryant's administration in the estate of Bailey Bryant do immediately make Report to court -

Benjamin Bunn late of the County of Southampton (delinquent) who stands charged with having feloniously shot and killed Sir with a shot gun in the left thigh with intention to kill him this day appeared in court in discharge of his recognizance and was set to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County. Whereupon sundry witnesses were sworn and examined and the Prisoner by his Counsel fully heard: the Court after hearing the evidence and from all the circumstances of the case was of opinion that the said Benjamin Bunn is ought to be further prosecuted for the offence aforesaid for which he stands charged and Disclamation being made in the manner and nothing further appearing or being alleged against the Prisoner it is therefore ordered that he be forthwith discharged from Custody.

On Motion of William Ardel Esq. Ordered that the Clerk furnish the said Ardel with a true copy of the Register it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that the former copy has been casually lost or destroyed.

Ordered that the following proceedings of the Justice of the County the Bar and Officers of the Court be entered upon the Records of the Court to wit: That Justice and Melmettly Clerk of the Peace of the County late proceeding Attorney in the Court having been announced to the Court by Robert B. M. Motion Rutherford that the Court enter a decree of the great merits of the said Rutherford as Prosecuting Attorney as a Citizen and a man displayed in all its relations
