(The Will directing that the Executor should give no security and the court
requiring none)

Ordered that J. A. D. Hudson & J. Mahon Josiah Manly and John W. Burley
or any three of them being first duly sworn before the Justice of the peace for that
purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Nicholas M. Peckell dec'd and
return the appraisement under their hands to court

On Motion of Samuel Pope ordered that he be exempted from the payment
of taxes on his Negro Man and his being aged and infirm

On Motion of Hill and Ouland Merchants in this County the Court certify
that they are men of good Character and that there shall be a place for and
convenient for the Merchants in which it is situated for the Retail of Articles
of Spirit

On Motion of John R. Williams against Harday Superior At appearing
#466 to the Court that the defendant has had legal notice of the motion he was
specially called and not appearing Judgment is granted the plaintiff against
#1048 the defendant for forty four dollars and 33/100 the amount paid by the plaintiff
as security for the defendant with interest from the 2^d day of June 1840
and the costs
