Joseph W Parker made complaint to a Justice of the peace of the County that William B Brantley his debtor was removing out of the County privately or absconded or concealed himself so that the ordinary process of Law could not be served on him: and the said Justice having granted an Attachment against the estate of the said William B Brantley returnable to the Court which has been levied on sundry goods and chattels. This day came the plaintiff and Samuel T Rawlings by their attorneys and the said Samuel T Rawlings filia a plea claiming goods and chattels taken by virtue of the said Attachment and the plaintiff filia his replication thereto praying that the matter may be inquired of by the County and the said Samuel T Rawlings the like: Whereupon the Court doth direct that a Jury be impanelled to inquire into the right of property and a Jury to wit James Drake William Sanford Thomas Butler Daniel D Cobb Aaron P Goodner John S Persons George Mear Bryant Holland Elisha Britt Harrison P Pope and William Hyricks being selected tried and sworn the truth to speak upon the issue joined upon this ~~case~~ day: were sent out of Court to consult of their verdict after sometime returned into Court and declared that they could not agree upon a verdict Whereupon by consent of parties by their attorneys James Drake one of the Jurors was withdrawn: and the rest of the Jurors first returning their verdict were discharged: And the case is continued till the next term for a new trial to be had thereon.
