to wit John D. Leland P. M. Bailey William Harris Nathan Turner John
B. Souther George W. Spring Patrick Dowd John C. Turner Nathl. Timmon
A. J. Timmon James Delham and William Edwards who being sworn to inquire
of damage in this suit returned & verdict in the following words to wit
"We the Jury after the plaintiff damage at thirty three dollars and
twenty cents with interest from the 4th of May 1846. Therefore it is considered
by the Court that the plff recover against the defendant the damage aforesaid
as aforesaid and his costs &c"

On Motion of William B. Harrell Ordered that John T. S. Main be
and is hereby appointed a special Commissioner for the purpose who is hereby
directed to take such and adjut an account of said Harrell's administration
on the estate of Archer Pord. and make Report to Court. id

Editha A. H. Timmons made choice of William S. Sehill as her Guardian
Thompson the said Sehill gave bond and security according to Law.

Ordered that Fred D. Delham Richard Parker and Mrs Holland do let
to the lowest undertaker the Repair of Lick bridge at old South Dry road
the same when completed and make Report to Court.

Thomas B. Dorrell Foreman, James Harris Benjamin C. Waller John
Stephen P. W. Dorrell Henry B. Vaughan Bethel Smith Joel P. P. Archer
Mildred Irwin Griffin George H. Gardner Morrice Broadbent Irving P. P. P. P.
Dowd Green Vaughan Pompey Johnson John Cott Bennett S. Griffin Thomas
Vaughan and William Cobb were sworn a Grand Jury of inquest upon the
body of this County and after having received their Charge withdrew and after
some time returned into Court and pronounced (they must pronounce) and having
nothing further to present were discharged.

A Writing bearing date the 20th day of April 1839 purporting the last Will
and Testament of Sampson Pord was produced in Court for probate and there
being but one subscribing Witness to said Writing and it not appearing to the
Court that the body of the said Writing and the signature thereto be his
in the hand writing of the said Sampson Pord. The Court refused to
submit the said paper writing to Record as the last Will and Testament
of the said Sampson Pord. And on the Motion of Jacob Delham
who made oath and gave bond and security according to Law. Certificate
is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Sampson
Pord do in due form

On Motion of Scott & Woodard Ordered that James H. Sehill out of the
principal of his money estate Francis and William pay to said Scott & Woodard
the sum of 14 dollars and thirty cents.
