Shadrack a negro man slave the property of Allen Stephenson of this County who has
been committed to the jail of this County charged with having on the 20th day of September
1848 feloniously killed & murdered Tom Chappell a free negro in this County was this
day set to the bar in custody of the keeper of the jail of this County and being arraigned
pleaded not guilty. Thereupon reading witness were sworn & examined and the prisoner
was fully heard in his defense by himself. On consideration whereof it is the opinion of the
Court that he is not guilty of the murder as charged but that he is guilty of voluntary manslaughter.
Therefore it is considered by the Court that the prisoner receive a heavy lashes on his
bare back well laid at the public whipping post and that the Sheriff cause execution to be
done forthwith and then discharge the prisoner from custody.

Miles Worrell is appointed guardian to Eliza Elisha & Joseph H. Worrell orphans of
Jno. Worrell &c & thereupon gave bond of security according to Law.

On motion of Mildred Worrell Ordered that Miles Worrell guardian of Eliza
