Shadrack a negro man slave the property of Allen Stephenson of this County, who has been committed to the jail of this County charged with having on the 20 day of September 1848 feloniously killed & murdered John Chappell a free negro in this County was this day set to the bar in custody of the keeper of the jail of this County and being arraigned pleaded not guilty. Whereupon sundry witnesses were sworn & examined and the prisoner was fully heard in his defence by counsel. On consideration whereof it is the opinion of the Court that he is not guilty of the murder as charged but that he is guilty of voluntary manslaughter. And therefore it is considered by the Court that the prisoner receive twenty lashes on his bare back with laid at the public whipping post and that the Sheriff cause execution to be done forthwith and then discharge the prisoner from custody.

Miles Morrell is assigned guardian to Elijah Calisha & Joseph H. Morrell orphans of Seph Morrell dec'd & thereupon he gave bond & security according to Law.

On motion of Mildred Morrell Ordered that Miles Morrell guardian of Elijah Calisha & Joseph H. Morrell pay to her \$15. each for the last twelve months & \$15 each for the next twelve months for Calisha & Joseph H. Morrell out of the principal of said wards estate.
