Therefore the court doth adjudge order and decree that Nathan Thomas Executor of Nathan Jones dec'd. who was Executor of Mary Jones do pay to Anthony Woodard and Sally his wife the sum of ONE hundred and twenty three dollars and twenty six cents with interest thereon from the 31st day of December 1843 until paid and that the said Woodard & wife shall not be required to give to the said Nathan Thomas any bond with security requiring them to refund the said money in case there should be a deficiency of assets to pay the debts owing by Mary Jones dec'd.
