

For Reasons appearing to the Court: It is ordered that the Margraves of the poor do bind James and Nicholas Lewis infant children of Rebecca Lewis for term to William A. Bell according to Law. And the Court consider that twenty eight dollars will be the reasonable annual value of the service of the James and thirty dollars <sup>the reasonable annual value of the Nicholas</sup> from the term that they arrive to the age of fourteen years in the art trade or business of a farmer: And the persons of the poor by whom the order shall be executed in addition to the Indentures of the apprentices shall take from the Master bond with satisfactory security in a penalty equal to double the value of the service of the apprentice for the whole term and payable to the Committee of Virginia: Conditioned to account for the value of such service according to Law

Thomas Ritchy is appointed surveyor of the Road leading from the upper part at Jack's Parkers to Buckhorn Swamp: in place of James D. Holt removed: And it is ordered that the usual hands be worked thereon

An Inventory & appraisement of the Estate of Joseph Buatins was returned and ordered to be recorded.

Oralbert Low who stands charged as Oath by Mary & Mary a free single woman of this County with being the father of her bastard child appeared in Court in discharge of his Recognizance: and the said Mary & Mary and their witnesses being sworn and examined the Court after hearing the evidence and from all the circumstances of the case did adjudge the said Oralbert Low not to be the father of the said child: Therefore it is ordered that the said prosecution be dismissed

An Account of Benjamin C. Everett Comdr. amounting to \$5.31 is ordered to be delivered to the Auditor of public Accounts for his examination and payment

On Motion of Chas. Joyner: ordered that S. L. Buffum who is appointed special Commissioner for the purpose do state with and adjust an Account of Joyner's administration on the Estate of Jas. Joyner and make Report to Court

On Motion of Bally. Mansford ordered that William Joyner eldest of Amos Joyner state an Account of his administration with relation of Amos Joyner before one of the Commissioners of the Court

Ordered that the Estate of Benjamin Cobb do be committed to the hands of J. Dardent Esq. for administration according to Law

Ordered that all the acting Justices of the peace of this County be summoned to the first day of the next term to consider the propriety of adopting the Great Seal of the County
