

remained Judgment against him, and nothing being said or alledged in delay of Judgment, it is considered by the Court, that he be hanged by the Neck until he be dead, And that execution of the Judgment be made and done upon him the said Henry, on Friday the first day of March - 1850, - between the hours of Ten in the fore noon and two in the after noon, of the same day; at the usual place of execution: And thereupon he is remanded to jail; and the Court ascertain the value of the said Henry at the cash price set, which he would sell at public sale, with the knowledge of his guilt to be seven hundred Dollars;

Alexander Myrick who has been duly Commissioned Sheriff of the County by a Commission from the Governor under the seal of the Commonwealth, dated the 15th day of December 1849 this day appeared in Court and entered into and acknowledged bonds with security, conditions as the Law directs; which bonds were acknowledged by the obligors therein named and ordered to be recorded. And the said Myrick also qualified by taking the sworn Oath prescribed by Law;

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
