Clements, and shall not depart, either without leave of the said Court, then this Recognizance to be void or she to remain in full force and virtue.

Be it Remembered, that William M. Everett, George Parker, Micajah B. Cole, and Jno Turner, her in Court severally acknowledge themselves to be indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia in the sum of \$300. each, to be paid of their respective Goods and Chattels, Lands and Tenements; And for the use of the Commonwealth rendered; Yet upon this Condition that if the said above named Witnesses shall personally appear before the Justice of the County Court of Southhampton on the first day of the next Term, then and there to give evidence on behalf of George J. Clements, charged with having maliciously and unlawfully stabbing W^m Brant; and shall not depart, either without leave of the said Court, then this Recognizance shall be void or she remain in full force.

Honny B. Buss, who stands charged with having maliciously and feloniously murdered Thomas H. Fife was again led to the bar in custody of the factor of the County; and throughout sundry witnesses were sworn and examined and the prisoner by his Counsel fully heard; The Court after hearing the testimony and from all the circumstances of the case, are of opinion that the Prisoner ought to be tried for the said offence, at the next Term of the Circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery for this County; and therefore he is remanded to jail.

Be it Remembered that Samuel Daugherty ^{for himself} and wife, Mary, and W^m Barham her in Court, severally acknowledge themselves indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia in the sum of three hundred Dollars each to be paid of their respective Goods and Chattels, Lands and Tenements, and for the use of the Commonwealth rendered; Yet upon this Condition that if the said Samuel Daugherty and wife, Mary and W^m Barham shall personally appear before the Judge of the Circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery for Southhampton County, at the Court house on the first day of the next Term of said Court, then and there such evidence as they know on behalf of the Commonwealth against Henry B.
