

said O'Brien enter into recognizance for his appearance here the first day of the next Quarterly Sessions to answer an indictment to be presented against him by the Grand Jury. The said O'Brien to be bound in the sum of \$100. with two securities in the sum of \$50. each. Whereupon the said John O'Brien with Robert Murray & Thomas P. Pettow his securities here in court acknowledge themselves to be indicted to the Commonwealth of Virginia: that is to say, the said O'Brien in the sum of \$100 and the said Murray & Pettow in the sum of \$50 each of their goods and chattels, lands and tenements to be levies and to the use of the said Commonwealth to be waived. Yet upon this condition, that if the said John O'Brien shall personally appear before the Justice of this Court on the first day of the next Quarterly Term to answer an indictment to be presented against him by the Grand Jury at that Term for the misdemeanor aforesaid, and shall not depart thence without the leave of the said Court, Then this recognizance is to be void.

The Clerk this day returned a certificate in these words (here insert it) and the said James J. Williams was this day set to the bar in custody of the Jailor of this County and was charged with maliciously and unlawfully beating Patrick Rowe with intention in so doing to maim, disfigure, disable or kill the said Patrick Rowe. On the motion of the attorney for the Commonwealth and for reasons appearing to the Court, the examination of the said James J. Williams is continued until the next Term of this Court. And on the motion of the said James J. Williams and the Court being of opinion that this is a bailable case he is allowed to give Bail. The said James J. Williams in the sum of \$500 with good security in the like sum of \$500. for his appearance here at the next Term of this Court to stand his examination for the offence with which he stands charged. And the said James J. Williams is remanded to jail until said bail be given.
