It is ordered to be certified that satisfactory evidence has been adduced to the Court, that Samuel Corbit Sr. was a pensioner of the United States at the rate of thirty two dollars and sixty six cents per annum, was a Resident of the County of Southampton, in the State of Virginia, and died on the 4th day of November 1849, that he left no widow - that he left nine children whose names are Nels Corbit, William T. Corbit, Samuel Corbit, Rebecca English, formerly Corbit, Sally English formerly Corbit, Hollans Carr formerly Corbit, Fanny Carr formerly Corbit, Martha English formerly Corbit, and Johnson Corbit. Administration upon the estate of Samuel Corbit Sr. was granted Samuel Corbit with the approval and consent of the other children -
